



OUR COVID-19 STRATEGY

As we are trying to get back to some degree of normality following the Covid-19 Pandemic, Pasta n' Play will be complying with all the government legislation and guidelines during our cooking classes. We will do this in the safest way possible to both mitigate/minimise the risk and we will try to make the day as comfortable and enjoyable as possible for you.

In the run up to and on the day of your visit we will be implementing the following control measures which support our reopening 'Risk Assessment':

- We ask all attendees to complete a 'Health Declaration' document about their health and contact with others upon arrival and before taking part in our cooking classes.
- Once in the premise you will be asked to wash your hands for the prescribed 20 seconds and continue doing so throughout the day at appropriate times.
- We will provide suitable social distancing measures where possible with an optional face protection mask for the entire duration of your cooking classes.
- All equipment, touch points (like door handles), workstations and general premises will be sanitised before the cooking class.
- Each student will have their own separate cooking stations as was previously the case.
- There will be no shared ingredients or passing of equipment between attendees.
- We recommend that you cover mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing; dispose of tissues and wash hands, in order to protect other students.
- Gloves will be used by our teachers but must be changed frequently and hands must be washed between glove changes and when gloves are removed.

We are very keen to welcome you back to learn more skills and techniques and we think that it is important to keep you informed of our strategy prior to your arrival on how we will comply with the latest government guidelines to make your day with us enjoyable, whilst meeting your expectations and manage your concerns.
